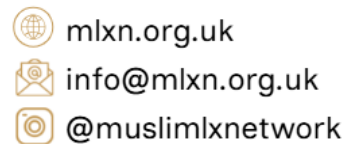

What information we collect, use, and why

Mailing List & Membership Registration

When individuals complete our registration form (hosted on forms.app), we collect:

- Full name
- Email address
- Phone number

A spreadsheet is automatically generated on the forms.app platform and is only accessible by the directors of MLXN.

Surveys and Feedback Forms

For surveys and consultations, we may collect:

- Age
- Lived experience (e.g., experiences related to mental health or wellbeing)
- Project-specific feedback (e.g., views on mental health resources)

Survey responses are created by the project lead.

Email Correspondence

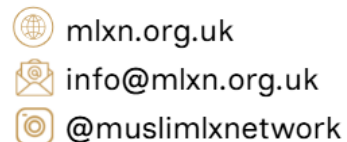
When individuals contact us directly by email, they may share:

- Name
- Age
- Personal information (including details related to mental health)

These emails remain within MLXN's shared mailbox and are accessible only to specific volunteers who manage correspondence. Sensitive information is not shared beyond this unless required for safeguarding.

1:1 Peer Support or Signposting Sessions

- Only safeguarding concerns are recorded digitally

- Safeguarding logs are used only if a concern arises (none recorded to date)
- Notes may be taken on paper during the session but are destroyed at the end.

Event Registrations

When you register for MLXN events via Eventbrite, we collect:

- Name
- Email address

Payment information is handled directly by Eventbrite. MLXN does not receive or store your card or financial details.

Donations/ Fundraising

Payment information is handled directly by Eventbrite. MLXN does not receive or store your card or financial details.

How We Use Your Personal Data

We only use personal data for purposes that are necessary, proportionate and connected to our work. These include:

Membership Communication

- Sending monthly newsletters via email
- Adding individuals to our WhatsApp broadcast list to share network events, updates and opportunities

Research & Project Development

- Gathering insight to improve our services and develop community-led resources
- Analysing themes and anonymised feedback
- Ensuring that content reflects lived experience from diverse Muslim communities

- Providing signposting to services where appropriate

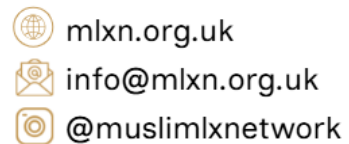
Safeguarding

- Recording safeguarding concerns if required
- Ensuring the safety of individuals and compliance with safeguarding duties

Event Management

- Processing registrations and communicating with participants
- Providing event updates and follow-up information

We do not use personal data for automated decision-making or profiling.



Lawful bases and data protection rights

Under UK data protection law, we must have a “lawful basis” for collecting and using your personal information. There is a list of possible [lawful bases](#) in the UK GDPR. You can find out more about lawful bases on the ICO’s website.

Which lawful basis we rely on may affect your data protection rights which are set out in brief below. You can find out more about your data protection rights and the exemptions which may apply on the ICO’s website:

Your right of access - You have the right to ask us for copies of your personal information. You can request other information such as details about where we get personal information from and who we share personal information with. There are some exemptions which means you may not receive all the information you ask for. [Read more about the right of access.](#)

Your right to rectification - You have the right to ask us to correct or delete personal information you think is inaccurate or incomplete. [Read more about the right to rectification.](#)

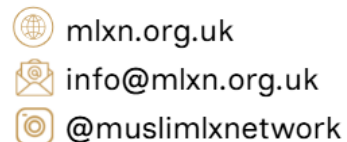
Your right to erasure - You have the right to ask us to delete your personal information. [Read more about the right to erasure.](#)

If you make a request, we must respond to you without undue delay and in any event within one month.

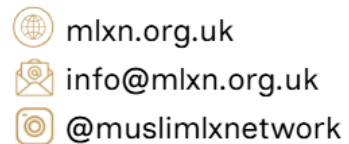

Our lawful bases for the collection and use of your data

Under UK GDPR, our lawful bases include:

Purpose	Lawful Basis
Newsletters, updates, WhatsApp list	Consent
Surveys and project feedback	Explicit consent
Email enquiries	Legitimate interests (responding to you effectively)
Safeguarding	Legal obligation / Vital interests
Event registrations	Contract (providing the event you have booked)
Volunteer coordination	Legitimate interests
Fundraising	Consent

Who Has Access to Your Data

Access is strictly limited to individuals who need it for their role within MLXN:

- Directors
- Relevant project leads
- Designated safeguarding lead

We do not sell, share or transfer personal information to third parties for marketing or commercial purposes.

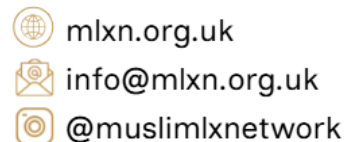
Eventbrite and forms.app act as processors and provide the platforms for data collection. They operate under their own privacy policies and GDPR compliance.

How We Store and Protect Your Data

We take data security seriously.

- Membership data is stored within forms.app's secure platform
- Survey data is stored securely and only accessible to authorised project leads
- Emails are kept in secure MLXN email accounts
- Digital safeguarding records are stored securely and access-restricted

We keep data only for as long as necessary for the purpose for which it was collected.

Data Retention

We retain personal data based on the following principles:

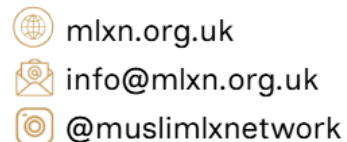
Data Type	Retention Period
Membership data	Until membership is withdrawn or you unsubscribe
Survey responses	Until project completion + up to 1 year
General enquiries	12-24 months unless there is a safeguarding concern
Peer-support notes	Destroyed immediately after support ends unless there is a safeguarding concern
Safeguarding records	As required by safeguarding law (typically 7-25 years depending on case type and age.)
Event registrations	Retained in Eventbrite for administrative purposes
Service delivery record	3–6 years after last contact (or longer if legally required).
Financial records	6 years

Children's Data

We do not knowingly collect or process personal data of individuals under 16 without parental consent.
